# The DAV also awards 10 scholarships each year, ranging from \$5,000 to \$30,000 to volunteers who meet the following criteria:

- The scholarship recipient must be 21 years of age or younger and has volunteered for a minimum of 100 hours in service to veterans.

- Volunteer hours must be accumulated at a VA medical center or DAV's Local Veterans Assistance Program. The hours must be credited to Disabled American Veterans.

- Scholarships must be used at any accredited institution of higher learning to include universities, colleges, community colleges, vocational schools, etc.

- Scholarships must be utilized in full prior to the recipient attaining the age of 25, or within 6 years of receiving the scholarship, whichever is later.

#### **REVISED OR ADDED INFORMATION IS IN BOLD**

- Scholars are not permitted to bring outside food in (other than bringing their lunch to school, or a classroom lunch activity, which is led by their teacher). If they have to eat lunch outside of the normal lunchtime, they are permitted to eat in the office.
- Please make yourself aware of activities going on at your scholar's home high school. We have scholars from many different home high schools, which makes it very hard to know what's going on at each.
- If your scholar is getting their drivers permit, a "No Pass No Drive" form needs to be filled out. You can get those from your scholar's home high school.
- Please remember Ignite scholars are not permitted to ride a different bus home with another scholar.
- If your scholar is out for an EHO, they are not to be in the building to catch a ride with another scholar.
