ACT

All Ignite 10th and 11th grade students will be taking the ACT at no cost, and they do not have to register to take them on the following dates:

- 11th grade students will be taking it online at Ignite on March 10
- 10th grade Kenton students will be taking it on paper at their home high school on March 24
- 10th grade Boone and Walton Verona students will be taking it online at Ignite on April 22

The **A**rmed **S**ervices **V**ocational **A**ptitude **B**attery, is a multiple-choice test that helps identify which Military Occupational Specialties jobs would be best for you.

The **ASVAB CEP** is given to high school students in grades 10-12, and also first and second year college students to help them figure out what career paths- military and civilian- could be ideal matches for them based on their strengths. There is no commitment to military service if you take the ASVAB CEP.

Ignite will be giving the ASVAB CEP on Thursday, March 26 at Ignite. There is no cost, but the deadline to sign up is Friday, March 20.


