



Just a reminder...

From the Nurse's office

Immunizations:

Parents, please make sure your scholar has a current, up-to-date immunization record on file at all times. Immunization certificates can be turned in to me or the nurse at your scholar's home school. All 11th graders who have turned 16y/o are required by Kentucky law to have their second meningococcal vaccine. If your scholar's immunization certificate is expired or missing doses you have a two-week grace period to turn in a current certificate. If you are unsure if your scholar is up to date, you can always call me or your scholar's physician to obtain that information.

Medications:

As a reminder, scholars are <u>not</u> allowed to carry any medication on them at school. If your scholar needs prescription or over-the-counter medications while at school, please let me know and I will make sure to discuss our policy and procedures for medication kept in the first aid room as well as any forms you need to fill out. A scholar with diabetes, asthma, and anaphylaxis may carry their

emergency medications on them as long as I have the appropriate documentation on file in the first aid room.

Illness:

If your scholar is not feeling well, please check their temperature before you send them to school. Scholars must be fever free for 24 hours without the use of medication before they can return to school after illness. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to reach out to me.

Canvas

Parents, you may have noticed a change in Canvas, as your scholar's average grade is no longer visible. However, all your scholar's individual grades are still visible (homework, tests, etc). Your scholar's running grade is visible in Infinite Campus. Make sure you are viewing Infinite Campus through Boone County District's website. Links to this can also be found on Ignite's website, and the Ignite Family Dashboard.

Severe Weather Policy

This is just a reminder of our severe weather policy.

If Boone County Schools are cancelled, school is cancelled for Ignite scholars, no matter what their home school district has decided.

If Boone County schools are on a Non-Traditional Instruction (NTI) day, Ignite scholars must log in and remotely work from home, no matter what their home school district has decided.

In the event that other school districts are closed, but Boone County Schools are not, Ignite scholars are encouraged to come to Ignite if they are able.

If they are unable to make it to campus, they should still log in to their course work and contact teachers to be counted as present.

In the event that Boone County Schools have severe weather this year, the Boone County Board of Education issued that the first three days would likely lead to complete cancelation of classes. After three severe weather days, the school district would begin using NTI days.

On a severe weather day, please be sure to check local news for the status of Boone County Schools.

Miscellaneous Info / Links

- Please make yourself aware of activities going on at your scholar's home high school. We have scholars from close to a dozen different home high schools, which makes it very hard to know what's going on at each. If you need to pick up your scholar early, please let us know ahead of time. Thank you!
- If your scholar is getting their drivers permit, a "No Pass No Drive" form needs to be filled out. You can get those from your scholar's home high school.

If your scholar will miss school for any reason, we <u>must</u> receive a **parent or doctor note** to excuse the absence. You may email the note to <u>Heatherm.Johnson@boone.kyschools.us</u>, or send it in with your scholar. Please be aware of the attendance policy at your scholar's home high school. Official attendance records are kept there and are based on policies of that school. <u>Also, please remember school starts at 8:00am at Ignite and scholars must be in their homeroom by 8:00am so they are not counted tardy or absent.</u>
