Dual Credit Classes

Hello, future Gateway scholar! I am Mrs. Knapp-Lindsay, the College Coordinator at Ignite, and I will be partnering with you on your Dual Credit courses.

Dual Credit coursework through Gateway, NKU, and Thomas More will happen whether you've chosen the in-person or virtual option. Your college courses will be listed when you receive your Ignite schedule.

Attention Scholars who will be taking Dual Credit for the first time: Please check your Boone County email and follow the directions to complete Gateway's application and disclosure form as well as a brief survey for Ignite if you have not already done so. The deadline is tomorrow, Saturday, August 1. Here are the steps to apply:

Brief survey for Ignite (must be logged in with your Boone County account only)

Also, if you <u>owe a balance</u> to Gateway for prior semesters, please login to your Gateway student account to pay it, or you cannot be registered for your new class(es).

A letter from the President

Dear Students,

Fall classes begin on August 17 and we are looking forward to the start a new semester. I communicated previously that our classes are going to be offered in a variety of formats. I want to clarify what those formats are, and how they will affect you.

Most lecture type classes that were previously scheduled for face-to-face will now be interactive live streamed through Blackboard Collaborate. Interactive live stream courses, also known as remote synchronous, offer the same benefits of as in-person classes such as real time interaction with your professor and classmates but with the advantage of being able to participate from anywhere with reliable internet access. You will meet via Blackboard Collaborate on the scheduled days and times.

If you do not have access to a computer at home, computer labs will be available at the Boone and Edgewood Campuses and at the Center for Technology, Innovation and Enterprise building at the Urban Metro Campus where you will be able to comply with all of the CDC guidelines to help you stay safe and healthy.

Lab or hands-on courses will be offered on-campus following all CDC guidelines (barring any disruptions from pandemic response). For all the ways we are keeping our campuses safe and healthy go to gateway.kctcs.edu/healthy-at-Gateway.

- 6. You will then see a list of all your classes. Click the "Section" of a course to see the class detail. See an example highlighted here:



7. Under "Notes" you will be able to see what format your class will be in.

- 5 Class will meet in-person according to scheduled days and times
- 6 Class will meet remotely via Blackboard Collaborate or in-person according to scheduled days & times see course syllabus
- 7 Complete online course
