## Vex Robotics

---

Ignite is extremely proud of our two VEX robotics teams! Our rookie team has started out strong and looks like they will have a very promising 2022 competition season. Our returning team PiBotics 38141B has already travelled to Michigan, Indiana, and Tennessee to compete at tournaments this year in addition to hosting an event in October and has already had an incredibly successful season. This team is only a year old, but they are tremendous competitors. The team has won Tournament Champions (IN), Skills Champion (KY), Tournament Finalists (TN and MI), and the AMAZE Award (TN) for their well-rounded, high performing robot. In addition to their exceptional competitive play, the team has also participated in the VEX Skills Challenge, where they achieved the second highest Driver Skills score in the world and where they are in the top 10 teams overall. VEX Robotics Competition features over 20,000 middle and high school teams from 50 countries worldwide.
