Governor's School for Entrepreneurs

[The Governor's School for Entrepreneurs \(GSE\)](#) is now accepting applications for summer 2023. Deadline for submission is Monday, Jan. 23, 2023. While all participants gain vital entrepreneurial skills through the program to use as they enter the workplace or continue into higher education, 30+ new businesses have already been launched by young alumni of the GSE program. Others have filed for multiple patents and developed new ideas and relationships that sow the seeds for more business formation. In addition, as a direct result of their participation in GSE, entrepreneurs qualify for some \$5 million in scholarship opportunities from Kentucky's universities and colleges.

This free, prestigious program will take place on Northern Kentucky University's campus in two sessions- June 11- July 1, and July 9 – July 29, 2023. All current 9th, 10th, and 11th-grade students are encouraged to apply.

Dual Credit students and parents: ONE WEEK UNTIL THE DEADLINE!

To be scheduled into your class selections, Gateway bills should be paid by 11/22/22. Target payment between 11/17-11/22. If bills are paid after that date, Ms. Anderson cannot enroll into spring classes. There are no exceptions to this deadline.

Students have access to their bills in their student services account via MyPath.

Payments can be made the following ways:

1. Log into your Gateway account, student services, financials tab IN A FIREFOX BROWSER (not Chrome)!
2. Call billing services at 859-815-7627 to pay over the phone.
3. Pay in-person at the Boone or Edgewood Gateway offices.

Ignite Parking Passes

Ignite scholars that drive to Ignite must have a valid parking pass visibly showing in their car in order to drive to Ignite.

THE DEADLINE TO HAVE A PARKING PASS IS TUESDAY NOVEMBER 22. PARKING CITATIONS WILL BE ISSUED AFTER THANKSGIVING BREAK TO THOSE CARS WITHOUT PARKING PASSES. Scholars can pick up an application and receive their parking pass in the front office at Ignite.

The passes are free.



Severe Weather Policy

You should have received an automated phone call from Ignite on Tuesday afternoon reminding everyone of our severe weather policy.

If Boone County Schools are cancelled, school is cancelled for Ignite scholars, no matter what their home school is.

If Boone County schools are on a Non-Traditional Instruction (NTI) day, Ignite scholars must log in and remotely work from home, no matter what their home school is.

In the event that other school districts are closed, but Boone County Schools are not, Ignite scholars are encouraged to come to Ignite if they are able.

If they are unable to make it to campus, they should still log in to their course work and contact teachers to be counted as present.

In the event that Boone County Schools have severe weather this year, the Boone County Board of Education issued that the first three days would likely lead to complete cancelation of classes. After three severe weather days the schools district, would begin using NTI days.

On a severe weather day, please be sure to check local news for the status of Boone County Schools.

We have scholars from close to a dozen different home high schools, which makes it very hard to know what's going on at each. **If you need to pick up your scholar early, please let us know ahead of time.** Thank you!
- ❖ If your scholar is getting their drivers permit, a **“No Pass No Drive” form** needs to be filled out. You can get those from your scholar's home high school.
- ❖ If your scholar needs to **change a class** on their schedule, please have them fill out the form on this [link](#) to request a schedule change.
- ❖ If your scholar will miss school for any reason, we must receive a **parent or doctor note** to excuse the absence. You may email the note to Heatherm.Johnson@boone.kyschools.us, or send it in with your scholar. Please be aware of the attendance policy at your scholar's home high school. Official attendance records are kept there and are based on policies of that school. Also, please remember school starts at 8:00am at Ignite and scholars must be in their homeroom by 8:00am so they are not counted tardy or absent.
