
We realize that a lot of families are struggling during this time, and we want to help.

As stated in the Boone County Schools Re-Entry Guidance Document provided by Superintendent Matthew Turner, all parents/guardians will be asked to sign the [COVID Back to School Form](#) that requires a commitment by parents/guardians to:

- Keep children at home if they are sick
- Take student's temperature each morning and keep the child home if they have a temperature at or above 100.4. Temperature will also be checked at school.
- Report to school nurse if their child has symptoms of COVID-19, a positive test for COVID-19 or were exposed to someone with COVID-19 within the last 14 days.


***Just a reminder! Students should provide an updated immunization certificate to the school before returning. Keep in mind that your student must have a second Meningitis on or after their 16th birthday, and 2 Hep A's spaced 6 months apart.**

Also, please check to make sure your child's immunization certificate has not expired. Even if your student is virtual/remote, it is still a state requirement to have an updated certificate.

Spirit Wear


If you ordered Sprit Wear, it has arrived!
